The school gates are open between 8.45am and 8.55am.

Any children who arrive between 8.55am-9.20am will be marked as late.

Any children arriving after 9.20am will receive an unauthorised absence mark.

If we do not hear from you, we will try to contact you by telephone. Absences with no valid reason will be marked as unauthorised.

If we can't make contact with you a member of school staff may visit your house. It is easy to inform the office of an absence.

School Attendance Panel Meetings

Every child should have an attendance of 95% or above. Just 6 days absence in a school year will cause the attendance to drop below this.
